
WHEN COMES THE RAIN



SUCH A LIVELY GARDEN






The two children let their imagination loose:

THE TASTE OF MIRABELLE PLUMS






A whole class separates them...





But, as Daddy said in the car on the way back. "Cheer up! That is no reason to be sad".




